

SUBJECT: Fort Rucker Environmental Officer Policy

1. Army Regulation (AR) 200-1 (Environmental Protection and Enhancement), 13 December 2007, paragraphs 1-23h, 1-25e, and 1-28f, require installation commanders to appoint and train environmental officers at appropriate organizational levels to ensure required environmental compliance actions are taking place. To meet these and other necessary requirements, this memorandum formally establishes the Fort Rucker Environmental Officer Policy.
2. All commanders and supervisors on Fort Rucker will ensure written appointments of environmental officers in accordance with AR 200-1. United States Army Aviation Center of Excellence (USAACE) Form 2729 (Environmental Officer Appointment Memo), located on the Sustainable Fort Rucker Web site (<https://www.fortrucker-env.com>) must be used for the appointments. USAACE Form 2729 appointments must be submitted to the Environmental and Natural Resources Division, Directorate of Public Works.
3. Environmental officers are required to attend the 8-hour Fort Rucker Environmental Officer Training Course. This course is required annually. Newly appointed environmental officers must attend the next available training course. This course will help environmental officers stay abreast of current and changing requirements. The Sustainable Fort Rucker Web site has additional information about the course as well as upcoming training dates.
4. This memorandum supersedes GC Policy Memo 15-35, dated 22 December 2015, and will remain in effect until changed or formally rescinded. For additional information or questions, please contact Fort Rucker's Environmental Management Representative at 334-255-1653.
